The year 2014 saw the completion of the design phase for the Terra Sancta Museum, which will shortly become a reality in the heart of the Old City of Jerusalem, once the necessary funds are obtained. The project is being promoted by the Custody of the Holy Land, directed by Association pro Terra Sancta in collaboration with the Studium Biblicum Franciscanum.



There will be a permanent exhibition and a dynamic cultural center desired by the Custody of the Holy Land, to encourage opportunities for encounters through the discovery of the history of this extraordinary land, in which the fates of many people living together in the holy places of the three great monotheistic religions have been mysteriously intertwined.

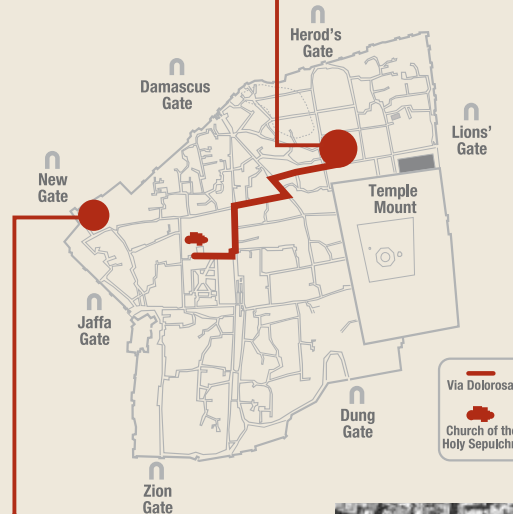
